1. Discuss referee comments to chapters

The NNR2022 Committee has developed an extensive procedure for handling the chapters in NNR2022. The main tasks during this spring, summer and fall will be to handle chapters according to the procedure and the main activities in Committee meetings. Chapters are now continuously peer-reviewed and will be adjusted by the chapter authors according to the referee comments, and comments from the NNR2022 Committee, before they will be announced for public hearing through the official NNR2022 webpage. The NNR2022 Committee discussed referee comments for the chapter on "vitamin B6". The chapter will be returned to the authors with both referee comments and comments from the NNR2022 Committee before it will be considered again for public consultation.

2. Discuss new chapters in NNR2022 on potatoes and fruit juice

The NNR2022 Committee has decided to include two separate food group chapters on potatoes and fruit juices. This decision was made after thorough discussions in the NNR2022 Committee and suggestions received through the public call. The first draft of these chapters is now ready, and the Committee discussed the drafts. Overall, the chapters are according to the instructions given by the NNR2022 Committee and only smaller adjustments are needed before the chapters can be peer-reviewed. Both chapters will be announced for public consultation when adjusted after the peer-review period.

3. Discuss chapters that are revised after public consultation

As described above, the NNR2022 Committee has developed an extensive procedure for handling the chapters in NNR2022. All input from the public consultation considered by NNR2022 Committee as scientifically valid and relevant will be forwarded to the authors for consideration. The riboflavin chapter has been announced for public consultation and all comments received were considered relevant and have been addressed by the chapter authors. All comments received through the public consultation are available at the public consultation website. The next step for the NNR2022 Committee is to integrate other aspects such as sustainability aspects, body weight, physical activity, and burden of diseases (all topics covered in separate background chapters). In addition, the NNR2022 Committee will start the work on setting the final dietary reference values based on the chapter and the advises given by the chapter authors. The final suggestion for setting of dietary reference values will be announced for public consultation at a later stage before the NNR2022 Committee reaches the final conclusion.
